Our approach is fully person-centred, placing the individual at the heart of everything we do. People at Warwick House enjoy a variety of activities from trips out, shopping, cinema visits and social outings to in-house favourites like karaoke and music sessions.

Warwick House is set over three floors, with two ground-floor bedrooms and four upstairs, each with en-suite facilities and personalised to reflect individual preferences. The home features a quiet room for relaxation, a large communal lounge, a spacious kitchen and dining area, and a separate dining room. Outside, there is a large, accessible garden that is especially popular for summer BBQs. Conveniently located within walking distance of local shops, the home benefits from excellent transport links, including nearby bus services and a train station with direct routes to London, Exeter, and Plymouth.

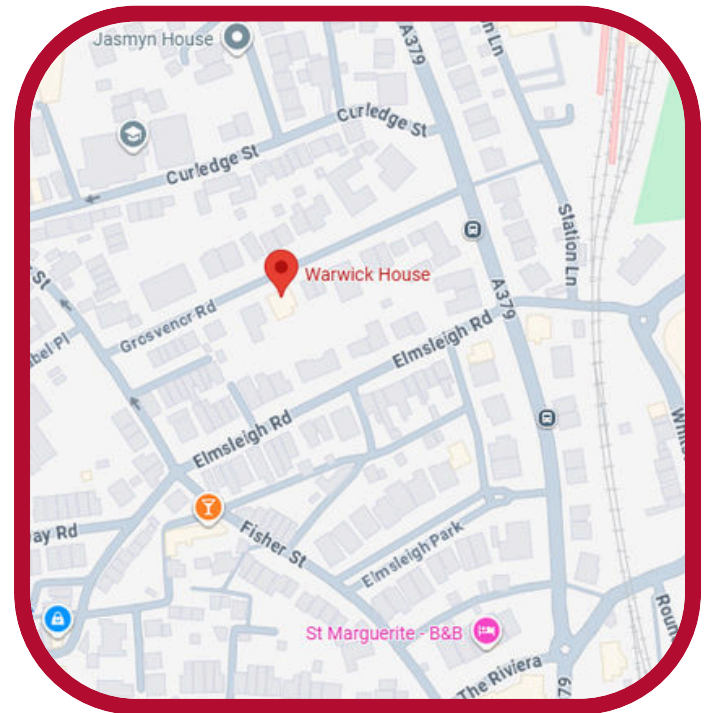
