

Birchwood is a registered service for those with learning and physical disabilities. We specialise in complex care needs such as PEG feeding, medication, stoma care and moving and handling.



## Introducing Birchwood

Birchwood is a 24 hour residential home and is registered for upto 15 people – this is due to being able to have a couple in the self-contained flat however currently it is occupied by one person and therefore our maximum occupancy is 14.

We specialise in complex health needs such as peg feeding, JEJ feeding, medication via pegs, stoma and catheter care. We have in house medication trainers to support with training needs of medication administration and regular competency assessments. We also have in house Moving and Handling trainers due to all of our clientele requiring moving and handling needs.

Birchwood prides itself on supporting individuals to achieve their goals and aspirations, this includes attending college courses, abroad holidays including a Mediterranean cruise in April 2023, and Cyprus in June 2023.

## About Birchwood

- The home consists of 3 wheelchair accessible bungalows.
- The 3 bungalows have 14 bedrooms in total.
- There are hoisting facilities throughout the home with en-suite facilities.
- All people we support have their own personalised bedrooms.
- There is a communal lounge, kitchen area and accessible garden.
- The home has its own vehicle.
- Close to shops and other amenities.
- Good transport links, including London underground and bus routes nearby.
