## Introducing Haroldstone House

Haroldstone House is a spacious home situated in a quiet side street in Leytonstone, close to the High Street and shopping facilities. The location supports four individuals who may have a learning disability and/or are on the autistic spectrum.

The people we support enjoy a variety of social and leisure activities both in the home and the wider community. Emphasis is placed on working together with the individual we support to develop life skills for their independence, enabling them to have greater choice and control over their lifestyle.

## About Haroldstone House

- Four bedrooms, each with an en-suite toilet and wash hand basin - additional bathrooms can be found on the ground and first floor.
- All bedrooms can be individually decorated to the tastes of the people we support.
- Shared access to communal spaces such as the lounge, dining room, and kitchen.
- The home also has a sensory room and a patio garden area where we have summer barbeques.
- Close to the high street and other shopping facilities.
- Five-minute walk to Leytonstone Station, giving excellent public transport links to central London and the South East.
