Introducing Rosewarne

The people we support enjoy a wide range of community activities, including swimming, college courses (e.g. drama, information, technology, communication, day service), socialising, cooking, and access to churches, pubs and coffee shops just around the corner.

Our dedicated staff team are highly experienced in supporting people with learning disabilities and complex care needs, such as NG feeding, PEG management, moving and handling and catheter care.

We work closely with every individual, their family, and health and social care professionals to encourage greater engagement with the wider community and to ensure there is a person-centred approach. Individuals are supported to learn and develop skills in communication; independent living; building on life skills; accessing services, resources and activities in the community; and building and maintaining relationships with friends and family.

About Rosewarne

- Our purpose-built accommodation comprises of three linked bungalows, with outside space and communal areas.
- Each bungalow has six bedrooms, a sun room and laundry room. There is a central dining room and kitchen area.
- All bedrooms have an en-suite shower, overhead hoists, assistive technology and environmental controls. There is a call bell system connected to all rooms and bathrooms. Rooms are furnished but can be decorated and adapted to the customer's wishes.
- Rosewarne is set in a beautiful private location, while still maintaining good links to Camborne town centre and local areas.
