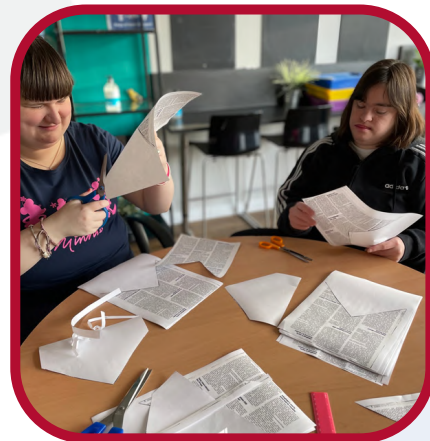


Sully Day Opportunities offer a wide range of social, educational and leisure activities to all individuals, supporting them to develop new skills, build confidence and meet new people.
