Introducing The Mowhay

The main house offers accommodation for two individuals, each with their own en-suite shower room. There is also a family bathroom. The living areas consists of a spacious kitchen diner and a comfortable lounge.

The lower level offers a semi-independent apartment for a third person. It is accessible via an internal staircase and its own entrance. The apartment comprises a kitchen, lounge and bedroom with en-suite shower room.

There is also a detached former barn which provides accommodation for one person. The open plan living-room has a high-vaulted ceiling and the sitting-area has French doors opening onto a terrace. The master bedroom has an en-suite shower-room.

About The Mowhay

Mowhay is a beautiful house set in some 5 acres of structured gardens including a stone circle, decorative fountain and apple orchard which also houses the 3 pet goats. It is an incredibly active home for 5 Autism and Learning Disabilities. The motivated and enthusiastic team support the individuals to access and enjoy a wide range of activities both at home and in the wider community, including attending church, attending a part time job, attending local volunteer projects, swimming, therapeutic massage, art and craft sessions and many charity endeavours.

The home is personalised throughout and the personalities of the individuals living there shines through in each and every room. There is evidence everywhere of a well-used and enjoyed home including handmade patchwork blankets and art works.
